

2012 CBN-PG SCHOLARSHIP ESSAY CONTEST

The Catholic Business Network Foundation of Prince George's County will award three scholarships totaling \$3,000 (\$1,500 - 1st place, \$1,000 - 2nd place, and \$500 - 3rd place) to eighth-grade students currently attending a Prince George's County Catholic grade school or religious education program, upon their admission to a Catholic High School in the fall of 2012.

TOPIC

Which Saint do you admire most and why?

RULES

- Student must be entering a Catholic high school in fall of 2012.
- Essay must be 500 words or less, typewritten.
- The essay must be submitted in duplicate and have a cover page that indicates the student's name, address, phone number, current school, intended high school, the name of a parent/guardian and signature of both the student and parent/guardian. No identifying marks, (i.e. references to current or future schools, name, etc.,) should appear on any part of the essay. There should be no graphics or other adornments.
- Essay must be in 5-paragraph form.
- Essay must be his or her original work.
- All essays submitted will become property of CBNF-PG.
- Essay must be mailed to CBNF-PG, PO Box 615, Lanham, MD 20703-0615 and postmarked no later than March 16, 2012.
- CBNF-PG reserves the right to make all final decisions with respect to eligibility and rules.
- Essay will be judged anonymously based on the following criteria: grammar, creativity and conformity with topic.
- Scholarship checks will be sent directly to the high schools in August 2012, once attendance is confirmed.
- If a winner does not attend a Catholic high school for any reason, a runner-up will receive the scholarship.
- Scholarship recipients will be recognized at the 14th Annual CBN-PG Awards Dinner & Auction on Monday, April 30, 2012.
